## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A ONE-TIME FEE FOR PERMANENT REGISTRATION PLATES FOR HISTORIC VEHICLES.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. G.S. 20-79.4(11) reads as rewritten:
"(11) Historic Vehicle Owner. - Issuable for a motor vehicle that is at least 35 years old measured from the date of manufacture. The plate for an historic vehicle shall bear the word "Antique"unless the vehicle is a model year 1943 or older. The plate for a vehicle that is a model year 1943 or older shall bear the word "Antique"or the words "Horseless Carriage", at the option of the vehicle owner. These plates shall be issued for permanent use on a particular motor vehicle and shall be valid until the vehicle is registered by a new vehicle owner."
Sec. 2. G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:
"(a) Fees. -
(1) Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a $100 \%$ disabled veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war.
(2) The one-time fee for a registration plate issued pursuant to G.S. 2079.4(11) shall be forty dollars ( $\$ 40.00$ ).
(3) All other special registration plates are subject to the regular motor vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount:

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1996.
