Short Title: Increase Cock Fighting Penalty.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PENALTY FOR COCK FIGHTING.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 14-362 reads as rewritten:

"§ 14-362. Cock fighting.

(a) A person who instigates, promotes, conducts, is employed at, provides a cock for, allows property under his ownership or control to be used for, participates as a spectator at, gambles on, or profits from an exhibition featuring the fighting of a cock is guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor. Class I felony. A lease of property that is used or is intended to be used for an exhibition featuring the fighting of a cock is void, and a lessor who knows this use is made or is intended to be made of his property is under a duty to evict the lessee immediately.

(b) A person who owns, possesses, or trains a cock with the intent that the cock be used in an exhibition featuring the fighting of that cock is guilty of a Class I felony.

(c) A person who participates as a spectator at an exhibition featuring the fighting of a cock is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.

(d) A person who commits a second or subsequent offense under subsection (c) of this section within three years after being convicted of any offense under this section is guilty of a Class I felony."

1 Section 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1997, and applies to
2 offenses committed on or after that date.
