1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT A PERSON FROM SENDING AN UNSOLICITED  
3 ADVERTISEMENT TO A CELLULAR TELEPHONE.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. Article 1 of Chapter 75 of the General Statutes is amended by  
6 adding a new section to read:

7 "**§ 75-36. Unsolicited advertisements to cellular phones.**

8 No person, firm, or corporation engaged in commerce shall send an unsolicited  
9 advertisement to any telephone number assigned to a cellular telephone service."

10 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
