**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO REIMBURSE CHATHAM COUNTY FOR ITS COSTS ASSOCIATED  
WITH SELECTING A SITE FOR A PROPOSED LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE  
WASTE FACILITY.**

Whereas, the General Assembly has appropriated at least \$800,000 to Richmond County from 1992 to 1996 for technical assistance grants for its site designation review committee for a low-level radioactive waste facility and for other expenses incurred by Richmond County related to licensing and siting a low-level radioactive waste facility; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Chatham County the sum of seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to reimburse Chatham County for the unreimbursed costs to Chatham County of its site designation review committee for providing technical assistance regarding the site selection of a low-level radioactive waste facility pursuant to Chapter 104G of the General Statutes and for other expenses incurred by Chatham County related to licensing and siting a low-level radioactive waste facility.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
