1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO REMOVE HURRICANE DEBRIS FROM
3	RIVERS AND OTHER PUBLIC-MAINTAINED DRAINAGE WAYS IN JONES
4	COUNTY IN ORDER TO PROTECT PUBLIC HEALTH AND TO PREVENT
5	FURTHER WATER QUALITY DEGRADATION.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
8	Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of four hundred thousand dollars
9	(\$400,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year to remove hurricane debris from rivers, creeks, and
10	other public-maintained drainage ways in Jones County in order to protect the public
11	from mosquito-borne diseases or diseases that breed in stagnant waters and to protect
12	water quality from further degradation exacerbated by slow or no flow waters.
13	Section 2. The funds appropriated under Section 1 of this act shall provide
14	grants for one-half of the nonfederal costs of stream restoration in Jones County, shall be
15	distributed as grants for stream restoration pursuant to the program for Water Resources
16	Development Projects under Part 8 of Article 21 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes,
17	and shall be matched by local funds on a dollar-for-dollar basis. The Department shall
18	give priority to economically distressed communities and units of local government.
19	Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
