There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 4 5 Insurance the sum of four million one hundred thirty-five thousand two hundred thirtytwo dollars (\$4,135,232) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to be allocated as follows: 6 7 \$1,603,259 to accommodate the rapid growth in HMOs and enable (1) 8 agency auditors to perform field examinations. 9 \$638,520 to provide additional field auditors and to bring the LEO pay (2) plan up to comparable State levels. 10 \$615,634 to provide additional information services for use with 11 (3) interagencies and industries. 12 \$500,000 to provide expert consultation and legal services to assist the 13 (4) State in rate cases. 14 15 \$303,853 provide regulatory responsibly (5) to for third-party administration and service companies for self-insured workers 16 compensation groups. 17 \$212,707 to provide additional Safety Services Engineers and 18 (6) 19 Inspectors.
