The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Notwithstanding G.S. 160A-360(a), the Town of Williamston may exercise the powers granted in Article 19 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes over an area extending not more than two miles beyond its limits. Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
