SENATE BILL 423

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR SENIOR CENTERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Aging, the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to support existing senior centers and to assist in the development of new senior centers. The Department shall allocate funds equally among senior centers throughout the State as determined by the Division of Aging. Expenditures of State funds for senior centers shall not exceed ninety percent (90%) of all funds expended for this purpose.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
