Short Title: Election Cycle Contribution Limit.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLAR PER ELECTION
CYCLE LIMIT ON ALL CONTRIBUTIONS THAT MAY BE MADE BY AN
INDIVIDUAL CONTRIBUTOR.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 163-278.13 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(a1) No individual shall contribute money or make other contributions totaling more than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to any combination of candidates, political committees, or both during the two calendar years that begin with an odd-numbered year."

Section 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 1999, and applies to all contributions made on or after that date.
