8	Notwithstanding the sentencing dispositions in G.S. 15A-1340.17, a person convicted
9	of a second or subsequent felony under G.S. 90-95 shall be sentenced to an active
10	punishment. However, the minimum term of imprisonment imposed shall be within the
11	range specified for the class of offense committed by the defendant and the prior record
12	level of the defendant."
