Section 1. G.S. 95-25.3 reads as rewritten:

Every employer shall pay to each employee who in any workweek performs "(a) any work, wages of at least the minimum wage set forth in paragraph 1 of section 6(a) of the Fair Labor Standards Act, 29 U.S.C. 206(a)(1), as that wage may change from time to time, eight dollars and fifty cents (\$8.50) per hour, except as otherwise provided in this section."

Section 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 2000.
