April 29, 1999 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT RELATING TO THE REINSTATEMENT OF STATE EMPLOYEE SICK LEAVE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Article 3 of Chapter 126 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 126-8.3. Reinstatement of sick leave. Sick leave for State employees shall be reinstated whenever a State employee returns from authorized leave without pay or within 10 years after any type of separation. Sick leave shall be reinstated when a State employee returns to State employment within 10 years after separating from employment in a local government position covered under the State Personnel Act or from employment at a public school, a community college, or a technical institute." Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
