2 **AN ACT TO CONVERT A TEMPORARY POSITION OF MAINTENANCE**
3 **MECHANIC TO A PERMANENT POSITION IN THE DIVISION OF FOREST**
4 **RESOURCES, DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL**
5 **RESOURCES AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO IMPLEMENT THIS**
6 **CONVERSION.**

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 Section 1. The temporary position of maintenance mechanic for the Rocky
9 Mount District of the Division of Forest Resources of the Department of Environment
10 and Natural Resources is converted to a permanent position.

11 Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of
12 Forest Resources, Department of Environment and Natural Resources, the sum of twenty
13 thousand twenty-two dollars (\$20,022) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to establish and
14 support this permanent position under Section 1 of this act, which sum represents the
15 difference between the sum of thirty-five thousand nine hundred nine dollars (\$35,909)
16 for the 2000-2001 fiscal year, the total cost to establish and support a permanent position
17 of maintenance mechanic, and the sum of fifteen thousand eight hundred eighty-seven
18 dollars (\$15,887) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year that was appropriated for the temporary
19 position in S.L. 1999-237, the Current Operations and Capital Improvements
20 Appropriations Act of 1999.

1 Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
