9 10 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services the sum of three hundred fifty-four thousand three hundred thirty-five dollars (\$354,335) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to be used to improve the implementation of the Plant Protection and Conservation Act under Article 19B of Chapter 106 of the General Statutes, which Article protects endangered and threatened plant species.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
