A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR SEXUAL ASSAULT PROGRAMS AND
SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration the sum of nine hundred fifty-nine thousand four hundred dollars (\$959,400) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of nine hundred fifty-nine thousand four hundred dollars (\$959,400) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to be used by the North Carolina Council for Women for the continuation of sexual assault programs and the prevention of sexual assault within the State. These funds shall be allocated as follows:

- (1) \$570,000 for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and \$570,000 for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for the 57 existing sexual assault programs.
- (2) \$289,400 for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and \$289,400 for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for 10 new sexual assault programs.
- (3) \$100,000 for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and \$100,000 for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for the North Carolina Coalition Against Sexual Assault.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
