2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR SEXUAL ASSAULT PROGRAMS AND
3	SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
6	Administration the sum of nine hundred fifty-nine thousand four hundred dollars
7	(\$959,400) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of nine hundred fifty-nine thousand
8	four hundred dollars (\$959,400) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to be used by the North
9	Carolina Council for Women for the continuation of sexual assault programs and the
10	prevention of sexual assault within the State. These funds shall be allocated as follows:
11	(1) \$570,000 for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and \$570,000 for the 2000-2001
12	fiscal year for the 57 existing sexual assault programs.
13	(2) \$289,400 for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and \$289,400 for the 2000-2001
14	fiscal year for 10 new sexual assault programs.
15	(3) \$100,000 for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and \$100,000 for the 2000-2001
16	fiscal year for the North Carolina Coalition Against Sexual Assault.
17	Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
