A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE COMMISSION ON INDIAN AFFAIRS TO FUND THE COMMISSION'S STATE RECOGNITION PROCESS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration, Commission on Indian Affairs, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to fund the Commission's State recognition process. These funds may also be used to fund a full-time Policy Research Analyst.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
