A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR ALZHEIMER'S ASSOCIATION
CHAPTERS IN NORTH CAROLINA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Aging, the sum of two hundred one thousand dollars (\$201,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred one thousand dollars (\$201,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated among the chapters of the Alzheimer's Association, as follows:

- (1) \$67,000 in each fiscal year for the Western Alzheimer's Chapter;
- (2) \$67,000 in each fiscal year for the Southern Piedmont Alzheimer's Chapter; and
- (3) \$67,000 in each fiscal year for the Eastern Alzheimer's Chapter.

Before funds may be allocated to any Chapter under this section, the Chapter shall submit to the Division of Aging, for its approval, a plan for the use of these funds.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
