9	two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$3,250,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for full		
10	funding of the Grassroots Science Museum Collaborative to enhance State programs in		
11	science and environmental education.		
12	Section 1.(b) The Grassroots Science Museum Collaborative is administered by		
13	the North Carolina Museum of Natural Sciences. Participating members of the
