A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO IMPLEMENT THE JUVENILE JUSTICE INITIATIVES ENACTED BY THE 1998 REGULAR SESSION OF THE 1997 GENERAL ASSEMBLY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

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Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of Juvenile Justice the sum of nine million three hundred twenty-five thousand ten dollars (\$9,325,010) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of eleven million seven hundred thousand four hundred ninety dollars (\$11,700,490) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for continued implementation and expansion of the juvenile justice services and programs enacted in S.L. 1998-202, the Juvenile Justice Reform Act, and funded in part by the 1998 Regular Session of the 1997 General Assembly.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
