Whereas, Family & Children's Service of Greater Greensboro, Inc., operates Clara House, the only shelter for battered women and children in Greensboro; and

Whereas, Clara House, built in 1905, suffered a devastating fire in 1997 which destroyed the roof and the second floor; and

Whereas, Clara House does not meet current fire and safety codes or the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act; Now, therefore,

- Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Family & Children's Service of Greater Greensboro, Inc., the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year for the construction or renovation of a new facility for battered women and children.
 - Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
