2	AN ACT TO DIRECT THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES COMMISSION TO CREATE
3	A PROGRAM BY WHICH VOLUNTEER LEGISLATORS WOULD BE
4	AVAILABLE IN THE STATE LEGISLATIVE BUILDING BETWEEN
5	LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS TO TALK TO GROUPS TOURING THE GENERAL
6	ASSEMBLY AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THAT PURPOSE.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	Section 1. G.S. 120-32 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
9	"(14) Establish a program by which, when the General Assembly is not in
10	regular or extra session, one volunteer member of the General Assembly
11	will be available on each nonholiday weekday to greet and address
12	groups touring the General Assembly. Legislators performing this task
13	shall be paid the travel and subsistence allowances allowed under G.S.
14	120-3.1(a)(2) and (3) ."
15	Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative
16	Services Commission twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal
17	year for the purpose of implementing the provisions of this act.
18	Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
