A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO DIRECT THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES COMMISSION TO PROVIDE
2 VOLUNTEER LEGISLATORS TO BE AVAILABLE IN THE STATE
3 LEGISLATIVE BUILDING BETWEEN LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS TO TALK TO
4 GROUPS TOURING THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND TO APPROPRIATE
5 FUNDS FOR THAT PURPOSE.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 Section 1. G.S. 120-32 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

9 "(14) When the General Assembly is not in regular or extra session, provide
10 one volunteer member of the General Assembly who will be available
11 on each nonholiday weekday to greet and address groups touring the
12 General Assembly. Legislators performing this task shall be paid the
13 travel and subsistence allowances allowed under G.S. 120-3.1(a)(2) and
14 (3)."

15 Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative
16 Services Commission twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal
17 year for the purpose of implementing the provisions of this act.

18 Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
