A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A MEMBER OF THE MILITARY WHO ATTENDS A
2 CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OR A COMMUNITY COLLEGE SHALL ONLY
3 BE CHARGED THE IN-STATE TUITION RATE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 116-143.3(b) reads as rewritten:

7 "(b) Any member of the armed services qualifying for admission to an institution of
8 higher education as defined in G.S. 116-143.1(a)(3) but not qualifying as a resident for
9 tuition purposes under G.S. 116-143.1 shall be ~~charged the out-of-State tuition rate;~~
10 ~~provided, that the out-of State tuition shall be forgiven to the extent that the out-of State tuition~~
11 ~~rate exceeds any amounts payable to the institution or the service member by the service~~
12 ~~member's employer by reason of enrollment pursuant to such admission while the member is~~
13 ~~abiding in this State incident to active military duty, plus the amount that represents the~~
14 ~~percentage of the out-of State tuition rate paid to the institution or the service member by the~~
15 ~~service member's employer multiplied by the in State tuition rate and then subtracted from the~~
16 ~~in-State tuition rate. Any member of the armed services who does not qualify for any payment by~~
17 ~~the member's employer shall be eligible to be charged the in-State tuition rate and shall pay the~~
18 ~~full amount of the in-State tuition rate.~~ eligible to be charged the in-State tuition rate."

19 Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
