**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO GREENE COUNTY TO STUDY THE  
FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING AN AGRICULTURAL BUILDING AND  
COMMUNITY COMPLEX IN THE COUNTY.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Greene County the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year to study the feasibility of establishing an agricultural building and community complex to be used as a Farmers Market and to serve the citizens of Greene County.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
