A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE NORTH CAROLINA MUSEUM OF
ART FOUNDATION TO ASSIST IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE FILM, KAY
KYSER-A LIFE IN MOTION.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to North Carolina Museum of Art Foundation, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year to be allocated to Mortarboard Productions to assist in developing the film, Kay Kyser-A Life in Motion, to document the life of Kay Kyser, one of North Carolina's most admired citizens and one of the nation's most gifted entertainers.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
