	Whereas, as more complex reform measures are initiated, it is essential that there be
	sufficient central office administrative support for principals, teachers, and other school
	staff; and
	Whereas, the current formula for allotment of funds for central office administrators is
	extremely complex and considered by many to be inequitable; and
	Whereas, it is important that an impartial study be conducted; Now, therefore,
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall study
7	issues pertaining to public school central office administrators. In the course of the study,
8	the Committee shall:
9	(1) Examine the responsibilities of central office administrators, with
10	attention to span of supervision as well as consequence of error;
11	(2) Analyze the number and ratio of State-funded administrators related to
12	the number of students and to the responsibilities of the administrator;
13	(3) Review and recommend to the General Assembly a more equitable and
14	understandable allotment formula; and

- (4) Review the credentials required for central office administrators.
 The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall make a final report
 on this matter to the General Assembly prior to January 1, 2000.
