A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CORRECT THE CANDIDATE FILING DEADLINE FOR THE ASHE
COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 128 of the 1995 Session Laws reads as
rewritten:

"Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 115C-37, the Ashe County Board
of Education shall be elected on a nonpartisan basis at the time set by G.S. 163-1 for the
general election in each even-numbered year as terms expire. The election shall be
conducted on a nonpartisan plurality basis, with the results determined in accordance
with G.S. 163-292. Candidates shall file notices of candidacy not earlier than noon on
the first Monday in June and not later than noon on the ~~last~~first Friday in July. The
names of the candidates shall be printed on the ballot without reference to any party
affiliations. Except as provided by this act, the election shall be conducted in accordance
with the applicable provisions of Chapters 115C and 163 of the General Statutes."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
