A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPORT PROGRAMS OF THE AUTISM SOCIETY OF NORTH CAROLINA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Autism Society of North Carolina, a nonprofit corporation, the sum of one million eighty-nine thousand eight hundred twenty-two dollars (\$1,089,822) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated as follows:

(1) \$250,000 to expand residential day services.

(2) \$450,000 for administrative cost-of-living increases.

(3) \$64,646 to replace lost funds due to reduction in CAP rates, changes in billing policy, and limits on specific funding categories.

(4) \$325,176 for Residential Services, Inc., operational costs.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
