## SESSION LAW 2000-167 SENATE BILL 1529

AN ACT TO ADJUST AND ADD FEES CHARGED BY THE REGISTER OF DEEDS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 161-10(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Except as provided in G.S. 161-11.1 or 161-11.2, all fees collected under this section shall be deposited into the county general fund. In the performance of his duties, While performing the duties of the office, the register of deeds shall collect the following fees which shall be uniform throughout the State:

. . .

(8a) <u>Vital Records Network. – For obtaining access to the Vital Records Computer Network, two dollars (\$2.00).</u>

. .

(19) <u>Miscellaneous Services. – For performing miscellaneous services such as faxing documents, providing laminated copies of documents, expedited delivery of documents, and similar services, the cost of the service."</u>

Section 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2000.
