A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE MATERNAL OUTREACH PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of three million two hundred thousand dollars (\$3,200,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of three million two hundred thousand dollars (\$3,200,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to expand the Maternal Outreach Program to serve children up to the age of three years from high-risk families. This program trains young mothers and dramatically reduces incidences of child abuse and neglect.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
