5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of
7	Juvenile Justice the sum of nine million three hundred twenty-five thousand ten dollars
8	(\$9,325,010) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of eleven million seven hundred
9	thousand four hundred ninety dollars (\$11,700,490) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for
10	continued implementation and expansion of the juvenile justice services and programs
11	enacted in S.L. 1998-202, the Juvenile Justice Reform Act, and funded in part by the
12	1998 Regular Session of the 1997 General Assembly.
13	Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
