**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE REHABILITATION OF SINGLE SISTERS HOUSE, THE STATE'S OLDEST COLLEGE BUILDING AND THE NATION'S OLDEST COLLEGE RESIDENCE FOR WOMEN.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to The Salem Academy and College, a nonprofit corporation, the sum of four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year for a planning and site development grant (Phase I) for the rehabilitation of Single Sisters House (1785) in Winston-Salem. Single Sisters House, an historic landmark in the development of women's education in America, is the State's oldest college building and the nation's oldest college residence for women.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
