A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FROM  
SERVING ON THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF A COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 115D-12(b1) reads as rewritten:

"(b1) No person who has been employed full time by the community college within the prior 5 years and no spouse or child of a person currently employed full time by the community college shall serve on the board of trustees of that college. Notwithstanding G.S. 115D-16, no member of the General Assembly shall be eligible to serve on the board of trustees of a community college."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to terms beginning on or after that date.
