A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PROVIDE TUITION REMISSIONS AND
TUITION AWARDS FOR GRADUATE PROGRAMS AT EAST CAROLINA
UNIVERSITY.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of nine hundred eight thousand eight hundred eighty-two dollars (\$908,882) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of nine hundred eight thousand eight hundred eighty-two dollars (\$908,882) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to provide tuition remission and tuition awards for the graduate programs at East Carolina University.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
