A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ENABLE THE CONSERVATION TRUST FOR NORTH CAROLINA TO SUPPORT THE WORK OF THE STATE'S PRIVATE LAND TRUSTS AND TO PROMOTE THE CONSERVATION TAX CREDIT PROGRAM FOR CONSERVATION OF CERTAIN ELIGIBLE LANDS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Conservation Trust for North Carolina the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of the hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to provide technical assistance and other support to North Carolina's private land trusts and to promote the State conservation tax credit program for land conservation pursuant to G.S. 105-130.34 and G.S. 105-151.12.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
