A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A NEUROBEHAVIORAL TREATMENT
PROGRAM AT BLACK MOUNTAIN CENTER FOR PERSONS WITH
TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of six hundred ninety-one thousand seven hundred seventy-two dollars (\$691,772) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of five hundred seventy-one thousand five hundred twenty-six dollars (\$571,526) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to establish a 12-bed short-term Neurobehavioral Treatment Program at Black Mountain Center for persons with Traumatic Brain Injury who have significant behavior problems. Of the funds appropriated in this act for the 1999-2000 fiscal year, the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) may be used for building renovations and vehicle costs.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
