**H 31. PRESIDENTIAL ELECTOR CHALLENGE.** Intro. 2/1/01. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Amends title to read, "TO PROVIDE FOR SELECTION OF PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IF THE ELECTION RESULTS HAVE NOT BEEN CERTIFIED BY THE SIXTH DAY BEFORE ELECTORS ARE TO MEET, AND BY THE GOVERNOR IF ELECTORS HAVE NOT BEEN SELECTED BY THE DATE ELECTORS ARE TO MEET." Revises proposed GS 163-213 as title indicates. Provides that the General Assembly shall meet in special session to select those Presidential Electors the Secretary of State has been unable to certify. Also provides that if certification is made by the Secretary of State under GS 163-210 at any time before noon on the day set for the meeting of Presidential Electors, that certification shall control.

**H 31. PRESIDENTIAL ELECTOR CHALLENGE.** Intro. 2/01/01. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 3rd edition. Changes title to *AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR SELECTION OF PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IF THE ELECTION RESULTS HAVE NOT BEEN PROCLAIMED BY THE SIXTH DAY BEFORE ELECTORS ARE TO MEET, AND BY THE GOVERNOR IF ELECTORS HAVE NOT BEEN SELECTED BY THE DAY BEFORE ELECTORS ARE TO MEET.* Amends GS 163-213 to provide for appointment by General Assembly if no proclamation is made before noon on the date for settling controversies specified in 3 U.S.C. 5, for appointment by the Governor if no appointment of any Presidential Elector has not been proclaimed before noon on the date for settling controversies under same federal provision, and sets standard for decision by General Assembly and Governor, under which they shall designate Electors in accord with their best judgment of the will of the electorate. If proclamation of electors is made before noon on day set for meeting of electors by 3 U.S.C. 7, then that proclamation shall control over appointment made by General Assembly or Governor.
