H 1358. EARLY INTERVENTION/PUBLIC HEALTH FUNDS. TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR EARLY INTERVENTION SERVICES AND ACTIVITIES. Appropriates \$7,358,869 for 2001-2002 and \$13,291,486 for 2002-2003 from General Fund to Dep't of Health & Human Services and specifies allocation of these funds for expansion of special assessment and evaluation services, for expansion of capacity to provide indicated services, for 24 new local family support programs and to provide support for 13 existing such programs, for expansion of mandated transdisciplinary resources teams, and for mandated integrated data system for tracking services. Appropriates \$184,283 in 2001-02 and \$200,000 in 2002-03 from General Fund to Dep't of Health & Human Services to expand children service coordination services. Appropriates \$5,125,625 in 2001-02 and \$1,708,541 for 2002-03 from General Fund to Dep't of Public Instruction and specifies allocation for expansion of special education and related services for children with visual and hearing impairments, for supplemental transportation support and equipment for preschoolers with disabilities, and for evaluation services for the increasing population of speech/language impaired children. Effective July 1, 2001.
