H 1416. STUDY HIV RISK/TREAT-RAPE VICTIM/HEALTH WORKER. TO ESTABLISH A LEGISLATIVE STUDY COMMISSION TO STUDY THE LAWS AND PUBLIC POLICIES REGARDING THE TREATMENT OF RAPE VICTIMS AND HEALTH CARE WORKERS WHO RISK HIV INFECTION. Creates study comm'n as title indicates. Comm'n to have fifteen members, seven appointed by the Speaker of the House (four of whom are members of the House), seven by the President Pro Tem. of the Senate (four of whom are members of the Senate) and the Sec'y of Health and Human Services. Specifies that six public members are to include a member of the NC Victims Assistance Network, a member of the medical community with expertise in infectious diseases, a representative of the pharmaceutical industry, a member of the NC Bar Association, and two members of the general public. Specifies issues to be considered and provides for an interim report to the 2002 Regular Session of the General Assembly and a final report to the 2003 General Assembly. Appropriates \$30,000 for 2001-2002 and \$30,000 for 2002-2003 from General Fund to General Assembly to carry out act. Effective July 1, 2001.
