H 1435. BILL LEE TIER DESIGNATION CHANGE-2. AN ACT TO AMEND THE MANNER IN WHICH ENTERPRISE TIER DESIGNATIONS ARE ASSIGNED UNDER THE WILLIAM S. LEE QUALITY JOBS AND BUSINESS EXPANSION ACT. As title indicates. Amends the small county exceptions in GS 105-129.3(e) to specify that a county with a population of less than 35,000 (was, 25,000) that would otherwise be designated an enterprise tier four or five area under GS 105-129.3 must be designated an enterprise tier three area. Effective when it becomes law and applies to designations made on or after that date.
