H 1710. INDEPENDENT GOVERNMENT REVIEW COMM./FUNDS. CREATING THE INDEPENDENT GOVERNMENT REVIEW COMMISSION AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE WORK OF THE COMMISSION. Creates the Independent Government Review Comm'n to review all activities of state government including the current funding and appropriateness of government activities. Comm'n must review state agencies, boards and commissions administered or funded by state; state's relationship with non-state entities receiving state funds; all state property holdings and then recommend changes to General Assembly. Provides that Comm'n will do its work through eight teams organized by the Governor and be assigned specific review responsibilities. Each team must include two members of the General Assembly (one from majority party and one from party with next largest number of members), one employee of the Fiscal Research Div'n staff as a nonvoting member, and three persons from the private sector (two appointed by NC Citizens for Business and Industry and one by Governor). Requires Comm'n to issue final report to 2005 General Assembly; Comm'n terminates when final report is filed. Appropriates \$1 million for 2002-2003 from General Fund to General Assembly for Comm'n. Effective July 1, 2002.
