**S 636. CHARLOTTE ENTERTAINMENT TAX.** *TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE TO LEVY A GROSS RECEIPTS TAX ON CERTAIN ENTERTAINMENTS OFFERED IN CITY-OWNED FACILITIES.* Authorizes a tax of 3% on gross receipts from specified entertainments.

City may use the tax proceeds only for purposes of (1) acquiring, constructing or maintaining convention centers, civic centers, performing arts centers, coliseums, auditoriums, and museums, (2) parking for those listed facilities, or (3) promoting tourism.
