**S 1350. AMEND HARNETT HUNTING FROM RIGHT-OF-WAY. TO AMEND THE PROHIBITION AGAINST HUNTING FROM THE RIGHT-OF-WAY IN HARNETT COUNTY.** Rewrites sec. 1, SL 1997-103 to make it unlawful to hunt with a loaded firearm (including center-fire rifles, shotguns, or pistols with barrel lengths greater than five and one-half inches) on, from, or across a public street or highway. Defines "loaded firearm" to mean a firearm with shells in the chamber magazine or clip. Makes it a prima facie violation to possess a loaded firearm outside of a vehicle within the right-of-way of a public road. Makes crime punishable as a misdemeanor as follows: (1) first conviction: fine of \$300 - \$500, or 30 days in prison; (2) second conviction: fine of \$500 - \$700 and suspension of violator's hunting license for one year, or 30 days in prison; and (3) third conviction within three years: a fine of \$2,000 and suspension of hunting license for three years, or 60 days in prison. Applies only to Harnett County. Effective Oct. 1, 2002.
