 - **SECTION 1.** G.S. 14-45.1(e) reads as rewritten:
- 7 "(e) Nothing in this section shall require a physician licensed to practice medicine 8 in North Carolina or any nurse physician, nurse, pharmacist, or other health care

9 <u>provider</u> who shall state an objection to abortion on moral, ethical, or religious grounds,

10 to perform or participate in medical procedures or prescribe or dispense drugs or

11 <u>devices</u> which result in an abortion. The refusal of such physician the physician, nurse,

12 pharmacist, or other health care provider to perform or participate in these medical

13 procedures or prescribe or dispense drugs or devices which result in an abortion shall

14 not be a basis for damages for such refusal, or for any disciplinary or any other 15 recriminatory action against such physician.the person."
