A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT AUTHORIZING COUNTIES TO ADOPT ORDINANCES REGARDING  
BATHROOM FACILITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any provision of the State Building Code or any public or local law to the contrary, including Chapter 143 of the General Statutes, counties may establish by ordinance the requirements for bathroom facilities, including the number of toilets required, in buildings that are used primarily for school sporting events.

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law, and only applies to counties that (i) have a population of 190,000 or more according to the most recent decennial federal census and (ii) border both another state and a county with a population of 650,000 or more according to the most recent decennial federal census.
