6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
7	SECTION 1. The General Assembly finds:	
8	(1)	The design volume of sanitary sewage systems for day care centers is
9		governed by 15A North Carolina Administrative Code 18A.1949 and
10		is based on a minimum design daily flow of 15 gallons per day per
11		person.
12	(2)	The current rule does not take into consideration the number of
13		children wearing diapers attending the day care center.
14	(3)	The current rule is based on a minimum design daily flow that is
15		unreasonably high.
16	(4)	The current rule severely restricts the ability of a day care center to
17		expand at its current facility.
18	(5)	The current rule should be amended to take into account the children
19		who wear diapers and thereby make no or much less use of the sewage

SECTION 2. The Commission for Health Services shall reconsider the minimum design daily flow used to determine the proper design volume of sanitary sewage systems for day care centers under 15A North Carolina Administrative Code 18A.1949 and amend the rule accordingly. The Commission for Health Services shall report its proposed rule change to the General Assembly and to the Environmental Review Commission no later than December 1, 2001.
