A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO MODIFY THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF NORTH CAROLINA
NATIONAL GUARD PENSIONS TO PROVIDE FOR CONTINUED
PAYMENTS TO A DECEASED INDIVIDUAL'S SPOUSE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

 SECTION 1. G.S. 127A-40(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Payment to a retired member of the North Carolina national guard under the provisions of this section will cease at the death of the individual and no payment will be made to beneficiaries or to the decedent's estate individual. Payments shall continue, in the same amount, to the spouse, if any, of the deceased individual in the same manner as the pension is paid to the spouse of a deceased individual who was entitled to retired pay for nonregular service at the time of his death under the applicable provisions of the United States Code."

SECTION 2. The Secretary of Crime Control and Public Safety shall report to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations, prior to April 1, 2002, on any additional statutory provisions needed to implement Section 1 of this act.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2002.
