The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. The Revenue Laws Study Committee shall so	tudy the fiscal
impact of amending the formula used to apportion the income of multista	te corporations
to this State and its comparisons with other states' treatment of multistat	e corporations.
Currently, North Carolina uses a three-factor formula that allocates a	and apportions
income of multistate corporations doing business in North Carolina base	ed on a payroll
factor, property factor, and sales factor. Under the formula, sales receive	a fifty percent
(50%) weighting while payroll and property each receive a twenty-five	percent (25%)
weighting. The Revenue Laws Study Committee shall study the fis	scal impact of
amending the formula including amending the double-weighted sales fact	or formula to a
three-factor formula. The Revenue Laws Study Committee may repo	rt its findings,
together with any recommended legislation, to the 2002 Regular Session	on of the 2001
General Assembly and shall make a final report, together with any	recommended
legislation, to the 2003 General Assembly.	

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
