SECTION 1. G.S. 20-127 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

safety glass approved by the Commissioner that is:		
<u>(1)</u>	Free from cloudiness, distortion, or other obstructions to	the driver's
	<u>vision of the road.</u>	
<u>(2)</u>	Free from cracks, scratches, or breaks that obstruct the dri	ver's vision
	of the road.	
<u>(3)</u>	Free from all stickers except those provided for by law."	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2001.
